## **5GENESIS Project Overview**

The fifth generation of mobile technology (5G) is positioned to address the demands and business contexts of IMT 2020 and beyond. The "Genesis of 5G" has entered the crucial phase of experimentation, and currently faces the challenge to validate the 5G network KPIs and verify the 5G technologies with an end to end approach. In this context, the 5GENESIS project will validate 5G KPIs for various 5G use cases, in both controlled set ups and largescale events. This will be achieved by bringing together results from a considerable number of EU projects as well as the partners' internal R&D activities in order to realise an integrated End to end 5G Facility. The 5GENESIS consortium is comprised by 29 partners from 12 countries, i.e., Germany, France, UK, Spain, Italy, Ireland, Israel, Greece, Cyprus, Norway, Sweden, and Portugal. As a result of this partnership, five platforms have been created in order to support the project's needs. Athens, Málaga, Limassol, Surrey and Berlin are the five platforms of the **5GENESIS** Facility.

#### The **5GENESIS Facility** will:

- Implement and verify all evolutions of the 5G standard, via an iterative integration and testing procedure;
- Engage a wide diversity of technologies and chain innovations that span over all domains, achieving fullstack coverage of the 5G landscape;
- Unify heterogeneous physical and virtual network elements under a common coordination and openness framework exposed to experimenters from the vertical industries and enabling end to end slicing and experiment automation; and
- Support further experimentation projects, in particular those focused on vertical markets.





### **Dissemination and Communication Channels**

In order to effectively communicate information about the 5GENESIS project and the events which will be held, communication channels have been created in order to promote 5GENESIS to the broad public.

# **General Assembly Meetings**

The second plenary meeting took place at Intel/Infineon Campeon headquarters in Munich, Germany, from 29th to 31st of August 2018. In this 3-day meeting, the progress of the first months was evaluated, action plans were revised and additional targets were set. First deliverables are under editing and the first milestones are met.
